Agreed to endorse such transactions intended to support normal business transaction without general trading conditions, transaction regarding rental or lease of immovable property not exceeding 3 years, and transaction relating to assets or services with connected parties according to above details, as they were considered to be normal business transactions, representing reasonable prices and other conditions concerned.

Furthermore, such transactions should contribute to the company's further benefits, as well as help strengthen the company's business potential further, thereby promoting mutual business developments for the parties concerned.

### 9. Transaction volume :

Above transactions came under the scope of connected transactions for listed companies as specified in Notification of The Capital Market Supervisory Board No. Tor Chor. 21/2551, on rules for connected transactions being intended as supporting normal business transaction without general trading conditions, transaction regarding rental or lease of immovable property of not exceeding 3 years, and transaction relating to assets or services having transaction volume larger than Baht 1 million but less than Baht 20 million, or otherwise more than 0.03% but less than 3% of net tangible assets (NTA), whichever may be greater. Since 0.03% of the company's NTA as of June 30, 2019, stood at Baht 1.68 million, as compared to 3% of such amount for Baht 168.49 million, therefore, such transactions volume warranted the company to seek approval form The Board of Directors and report the information to the SET, without needing to seek further approval from the shareholders' meeting.

The company hereby reports to the SET accordingly.
